

# House Training Log



- Assign someone to be in charge of the puppy every hour of the day
- When it is your turn, look to see the puppy's activity the prior hour
- Show the puppy his/her leash and say your cue to go outside, ex. "Let's go outside!"
- Grab your treats and take the puppy outside on a LEASH to it's designated spot to potty
- Give the puppy about 5 minutes to eliminate. No playing with the puppy at this time
- If the puppy doesn't go potty, come straight inside, confine the puppy, and try again in 15 minutes
- Continue until the puppy eliminates outside. Praise the puppy and reward with a treat.
- Allow the puppy playtime outside before going back inside for continued SUPERVISED play.
- The older the puppy the longer he/she will be able to go without eliminating
- Feed your puppy on a strict schedule. Pick up the food after 10 min. Do not "free feed"
- Interrupt but do not scold puppy if he/she starts to potty inside. Take puppy to designated spot outside & Treat
- Record all activity in chart that follows. Watch for patterns

Puppies will usually need to eliminate after certain activities such as playing, sleeping, and eating
